About the Workshop

International Technology Transfer Innovation Talents Training in the Process of New Industrialization (Workshop) is an annual training program hosted and organized by MOST (Ministry of Science and Technology of PRC). The Workshop is a part of MOST's "Training Workshop List of International Training Programs", which is an annual Training that aims to promote technology communication and friendship between China and other countries.



The Workshop is arranged as training workshop divided into sections. High-Tech Visit & Culture Tour

The Summer Palace
The Summer Palace, is a vast ensemble of lakes, gardens and palaces in Beijing, China. It serves as a popular tourist destination and recreational park. Mainly dominated by Longevity Hill and Kunming Lake, it covers an expanse of 2.9 square kilometers, three-quarters of which is water.

Zhongguancun Science Park
Zhongguancun Science Park was once called "Zhongguancun Electronic Street" back in 1980s. It is the very first science park in China. During the last two decades, Zhongguancun Science Park has gathered nearly 20000 high-tech enterprises, including Lenovo and Baidu, and has become China's most intensive science park.

The Forbidden City Beijing
The Forbidden City was the Chinese imperial palace from the Ming dynasty to the end of the Qing dynasty—the years 1420 to 1912. It is located in the center of Beijing, China, and now houses the Palace Museum. It served as the home of emperors and their households as well as the ceremonial and political center of Chinese government for almost 500 years.

Tianjin Binhai Hi-tech Industrial Development Area
Tianjin Binhai Hi-tech Industrial Development Area includes six science parks of Huayuan Science Park, Binhai Science Park, Nankai Science Park, Wuqing Science Park, Beichen Science Park and Tanggu Science Park. The Development Area mainly focuses on modern service industry.

West Lake Park of Fuzhou
West Lake Park was created during the Jin Dynasty (265-420) when Governor Yan Gao had water channeled here down from the mountainous regions to the northwest, in order to irrigate the fields. The large West Lake that was formed as a consequence has been a popular recreational destination ever since.

Qingyun Mountain Fuzhou
Qingyun Mountain is a national AAAA tourist area about 65km from Fuzhou. The mountain is consisted of four major scenic sections. It is mainly known for its beautiful waterfalls.
